## Opening Conference Sarajevo, 16 – 17 October 2017

### Call for Participation

The fairplay Initiative (Austria), the Football Associations of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia and Montenegro have started the joint project **Football Zajedno**, which aims to promote equality and non-discrimination. Football Zajedno will use the popularity of football as a medium for intercultural dialogue and the promotion of human rights and social inclusion. A focus is on the empowerment of disadvantaged groups and enhancing the equal participation of girls and women in and through football.

We now invite relevant stakeholders and potential future partners from the Western Balkans region to a conference in Sarajevo to kick-off the project and to discuss current issues.

### Criteria for Participation

We are looking for representatives of grass-roots groups, NGOs and other civic society organisations including minority groups, who use football and sport as a tool to overcome nationalism and to enhance human rights and diversity. In addition, we encourage football stakeholders (associations, clubs, coaches, players ) who are active in the field of social inclusion, anti-discrimination, human rights and/or diversity to join the event.

Please note: The target countries of the project are Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia and Montenegro. Conference Language is English.
